REGISTER EARLY FOR FALL REC SOCCER, SAVE \$

Registration for the fall recreation season will open on May 17. The discount rate of \$60 per player and \$145 per family of three or more is good until August 7.

After August 7 the registration fee reverts to the regular, non-discounted rate of \$70 per player and \$175 per family of three or more. Register online at www.roseburgsoccer.org.

In-person registration will be on Wednesday August 11 from 5-6 p.m. and Saturday August 14 from noon to 1 p.m. at the soccer building. We will no longer accept partial payment during registration. If you cannot pay in full during registration, register later when you are able.

A limited number of scholarships will be available for part of the registration fee. If you think you may need a scholarship, bring your Oregon Trail Card at registration.

FALL COMPETITIVE SOCCER TRYOUTS SET FOR MAY 10-13 AT FIR GROVE PARK

Competitive soccer tryouts for fall 2010 will be held at the soccer complex at Fir Grove Park May 10-13. Players must attend a tryout to be placed on a team.

Boys and girls Development teams (U10 & 11) and Classic teams (U12-U14) will be formed. Players from Roseburg, Glide, Sutherlin, Myrtle Creek, Winston and surrounding areas are eligible and encouraged to try out.

REGISTRATION

Online registration will open on April 24. Go to our website www.roseburgsoccer.org and follow the links to fall competitive team registration. Players must register prior to tryouts. If you cannot register online, contact RSA Director of Coaching at 541-391-3131 prior to coming to tryouts.

COSTS & PAYMENT - CLASSIC TEAMS U12, U13 & U14

The fall league fee is \$325 plus \$65 for a uniform if needed. Parents may pay in full when registering, or may use a payment plan. When using the payment plan the first payment is \$75 paid at registration, followed by five equal payments of \$50. The five payments will be on July, August, September, October and November.

COSTS & PAYMENT - DEVELOPMENT TEAMS U10 & U11

The fall league fee is \$135 plus \$45 for a uniform if needed. Parents may pay in full when registering, or may use a payment plan. When using the payment plan the first payment is \$35 paid at registration, followed by five equal payments of \$20. The five payments will be on July, August, September, October and November.

A limited amount of scholarships are available. Please contact RSA (541-673-0000) before tryouts to discuss scholarship details.

REFUND POLICY

If your child is not offered a place on a team, you will receive a refund of all payments. If your child changes his or her mind and does not want to play and withdraws before teams are posted on our website, you will receive a refund of all payments. If at any time during the season your child is injured or your family has to move out of the area, you will receive a refund of all payments. Refunds

will be prorated if games have been played. After the teams are posted on our website, we do not refund any fees, except for the reasons listed above. This is because of fees we incur before the start of the season; including uniform purchases, league fees and equipment.

If you know of a soccer player who would like to play on a fall competitive team but has not received this information, please pass it along and/or tell them to contact a committee member, or our DOC at 541-391-3131.

Fall competitive teams play in the OYSA statewide league, the SOCL regional league or the Eugene-area Kidsports league, depending on their age and skill level. Half the games are played at Fir Grove Park in Roseburg and half on the road.
